

Holiday Treasures Card Instructions



Jolly Deer

Additional supplies: Circle dies or an electronic die-cutter; sewing machine; clear glitter; white paint; gold ink or gold spray mist; pink pigment ink; adhesive

- Create a 4.25" circular card base. Die-cut the patterned papers into circles. Trim circles to create a background. Splatter gold mist/ink onto papers.
- Stitch along the edges of the seams, and stitch rosette trim to patterned papers.
- Use the Holiday Treasures cutting files to die-cut two stars.
- Ink stars with gold spray mist or ink and allow to dry. Paint chipboard snowflake white and allow to dry. Stain the "25" wood veneer with pink ink. Adhere coarse clear glitter to snowflake and wood veneer with clear liquid adhesive.
- Stamp the word "jolly" from the stamp set onto a scrap of cardstock.
- Adhere snowflake, "25," stars, and deer to card. Adhere sentiment under stars.
- Tie ribbon into a bow and adhere to the top of the card.



Joy

Additional supplies: Gold paint, clear glitter; white ink; Antique Linen Distress Ink or comparable; adhesive

- Trim patterned paper to 4"x5.25." Blend Distress Ink onto edges of paper (up to ~1" from edge). Use a dry paintbrush to paint edges of paper with gold paint. Allow to dry.
- Paint the snowflake with gold paint and allow to dry.
- Stamp "joy" from stamp set in white onto black star. Ink the edges of the star with white ink to create a chalkboard-look.
- Using a small amount of liquid adhesive, adhere clear glitter to the bottlebrush tree.
- Lightly distress the corrugated tag with white ink and gold paint. Adhere to card.
- Ink the wood veer token with Antique Linen ink and adhere to card.
- Trim lace tape and adhere over tag.
- Layer snowflake, tag, and tree with foam tape. Add star trinket pin behind tree.



Merry

Additional supplies: White paint or gesso, green watercolors or spray mists; Versamark; black ink; gold embossing powder; electronic die-cutter; hole punch; adhesive

- Trim patterned paper to 4.25"x5.5" and adhere to card base.
- Trim a 4"x5.25" white panel. Stamp and stamp off "tis the season" sentiment" over entire panel, overlapping the sentiments (stamp approximately 30 times). Heat set the background or allow to dry. Use slightly watered-down white paint to whitewash the background, allowing some of the sentiments to show through. Add more white paint to the center of the card. Allow to dry.
- Stamp the "Merry" sentiment in Versamark and heat emboss the sentiment with gold embossing powder.
- Die-cut the wreath from the cut files.
- Use watercolors or spray mists to paint the wreath. Splatter darkest green on the wreath when dry. Adhere wreath with foam tape.
- Adhere star trinket pin, red flower, snowflake, and sequin.
- Punch a hole at the top-left corner of card. Thread cord through hole and tie a knot.



Merry and Bright

Additional supplies: Background die or embossing folder; sewing machine; silver thread; adhesive

- Trim patterned paper to 4"x5.25" and adhere to card base.
- Trim trims and papers in successive lengths. Adhere "merry and bright" washi tape to a scrap of white cardstock and trim to fit.
- Emboss 3.75"x5" white panel. Stitch silver stars, patterned paper, red pom-pom trim, and green lace tape to white panel.
- Adhere washi tape and rosette to card. Create a loose thread nest with silver thread and adhere it behind the silver sequin bow. Adhere panel to card base.



Noel

Additional supplies: Gold paint; gold ink; green watercolors or ink; electronic die-cutter; sewing machine; adhesive

- Trim patterned paper to 4"x5.25" and dry-brush the edges with gold paint. Once the paint is dry, stitch around edges and then adhere the panel to the card base.
- Paint the chipboard banner with gold paint and allow to dry.
- Enlarge the "Noel" die-cutting file to ~2.5" in height. Die-cut the "Noel" and a star using the die-cutting files.
- Ink the "Noel" with gold ink.
- Watercolor or ink the star with green watercolors.
- Trim a leaf from the green mesh trim.
- Fussy cut the poinsettia from the patterned paper.
- Layer elements on card. Adhere the burlap flower with foam tape.



Snowflakes

Additional supplies: White spray mist; white paint; clear glitter; sewing machine; circle punches or circle dies; adhesive

- Trim letter patterned paper to 4.25"x5.5" and adhere to card base. Trim woodgrain paper to 3.75"x5.25."
- Paint snowflakes white. Once dry, use liquid adhesive to add clear glitter.
- Punch circles from patterned paper and curl up the edges of the circles. Layer circles and snowflakes onto woodgrain paper and stitch through (slowly!) with sewing machine.
- Splatter white mist onto card.
- Layer flair, wood token, sequin, green flower, and star trinket pin. Adhere panel to card base.
